

Bulky Pickup Reminders

The July 2007 Bulky Pickup date is Monday 7/23.

- In general, bulky pickup is for old “stuff” - brown goods, furniture, toys, metal appliances, old metal things, tires.

AND

- Computer equipment, televisions, batteries, and and mercury items (thermostats, flourescent bulbs). These items MUST be recycled – It's The Law. These items should be separated and put out for collection on Bulky Pickup.
- Do NOT put out the following: demolition debris, regular trash, yard waste.

Further tips/clarification:

- Demolition debris includes wood, siding, windows, sheetrock, insulation, old cabinets, shingles. You can take these items to the Norridgewock Transfer Station (use a pickup truck, not a trailer). If you need or want to use a dumpster, you can contact Riverside Disposal at 623-2577. You will be responsible for the cost associated with the dumpster.
- Refrigerators and freezers must be empty.
- Only three (3) car-sized tires and they must be removed from the rims.
- If you are putting out mattresses, chairs, cushions or sofas – things that absorb water - and it looks like we might get rain, please wait until the night before to put them on the side of the road. Remember, we pay for disposal of these items by weight and a wet mattress weighs a lot more than a dry one.
- Small engines must be totally drained of gas and oil. The safest thing to do is to remove the gas tank from the engine so there is no question about whether it has been drained.
