Individuals can take material (both trash and recycling) to Norridgewock Transfer Station for disposal. Recycling at Norridgewock Transfer Station is a “**single stream**” facility – all recyclables except cardboard can be mixed together; cardboard goes in a separate bin. A Sticker for your car is required and can be purchased for \$2.50 from the Town Clerk. The hours of operation at Norridgewock are:

Wed. - Fri. 9:30 a.m. - 6 p.m., Sat. 7:30 a.m. - 4 p.m. (closed Sunday-Tuesday)

Entrance is on the Airport Road in Norridgewock - NOT on Rt. 2.

NOTE: **No** trailers are allowed to unload at the Norridgewock Transfer Station.

### Recycling Reminders:

- **Curbside Recycling: Please separate**  
glass – clear and colored, crushed metal cans, newspaper, mixed paper, magazines & brochures, crushed plastic – all types except Styrofoam, flattened cardboard
- **BULKY Recycling: Dates in 2011 are May 16, July 18, October 3**  
Metal appliances, brown goods, tires\* ( 3 per household)  
**Universal Waste:** batteries, florescent tubes, mercury items, computers, televisions, electronics

Electronic equipment (computers, VCRs, TVs, etc.) will be recycled on Bulky Pickup Days – please separate these items from the other material

Fluorescent bulbs and batteries, thermostats, and thermometers containing mercury will be recycled on Bulky Pickup Days – please hold them until those days and do not put in your trash – please separate them

- Asphalt shingles and other demolition debris can be taken to Norridgewock Transfer Station. The shingles will be recycled if they are separated from the rest of the demolition debris. You will need a sticker available from the Town Clerk. Please Remember – **NO** trailers are allowed at the Norridgewock Transfer Station; use a pickup truck or van.
- Each household can dispose of 3 car-sized tires on Bulky Pickup days without paying a fee. If you want to dispose of more than 3 tires or oversized tires, you must pay a fee and get stickers from the Selectmen. The tires must be dismounted from rims. Please do not abuse this privilege – your taxes are paying the disposal fee for those 3 “free” tires .
- Used Ink Jet Cartridges can be mailed to a recycling center postage-free – envelopes are available at the Post Office. You can also recycle them at Staples and receive a \$3 credit toward the purchase of a new cartridge.
- **NEW** - recycle old medications. Keep them out of our water and landfills by picking up postage free mailers at any participating drug store.

### Recycling Tips:

The Merry Dumpsters encourage all residents to consider the ever increasing amount of Solid Waste we generate and the price to dispose off it. We are now paying \$78.08 per ton in tipping fees for trash. However, we don't pay any tipping fees for recycling. So Recycling really saves!!

If you are not recycling, please remember that the heavy items are also the easiest to recycle. Magazines, mixed paper and newspaper can be separated into shopping bags and when you have a full bag put it out on recycle day. Separating these items from your trash and recycling them would make a big difference in the waste stream.

Start a compost pile for food scraps if you don't already have one.  
If you do not wash and flatten tin cans, you can always flatten cardboard.  
If you do not clean glass jars you can always stomp on a milk jug.

Every little bit helps.
